"Early in the morning Joshua and all the Israelites went to the Jordan, where they camped before crossing over. After three days the officers went throughout the camp, giving orders to the people: "When you see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests, who are Levites, carrying it, you are to move out from your positions and follow it. Yet there must be a space between you and it, about two thousand cubits by measure. Do not come near it, that you may know the way by which you must go, for you have not passed this way before." And Joshua said to the people, "Sanctify yourselves, for tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you." Joshua said to the priests, "Take up the ark of the covenant and pass on ahead of the people." So they took it up and went ahead of them...Tell the priests who carry the ark of the covenant: 'When you reach the edge of the Jordan's waters, go and stand in the river." Joshua said to the Israelites, "Come here and listen to the words of the LORD your God...He will certainly drive your enemies out before you...the ark of the covenant...will go into the Jordan ahead of you...choose...one man from each tribe. And as soon as the priests who carry the ark...set foot in the Jordan, its waters flowing downstream will be cut off and stand up in a heap." So...the priests carrying the ark...went ahead of them...and as soon as the priests...reached the Jordan and their feet touched the water's edge, the water from upstream stopped flowing. It piled up in a heap a great distance away...So the people crossed over...The priests who carried the ark...stood firm on dry ground in the middle of the Jordan, while all the people passed by until all Israel had crossed over on dry ground." Joshua 3:1-17

Note: Joshua 3:5 has two sides to it. One side is what God will do, "for tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you." The other side is what you must do to position yourself for what God is about to do, "Sanctify yourselves"
