"And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, "These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: 'I know your works, that you are neither cold not hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth." Revelation 3:14-16

Introduction:

Cold water is refreshing, hot water is useful for medical purposes, but lukewarm water is neither.

The works of the Laodician church made Christ want to vomit the believers out of his mouth.

Key thought: Where do each of us stand in relation to this scripture? Are we all in for Christ, or are we lukewarm for Him. Is Christ pleased with us, or does he want to vomit us out?

Points to Ponder:

- Let's explore what it means to be "All In." Let's go on a hike!
- Hiking the Appalachian Trail (AT) is tough, but so is our walk with Christ.
- How did you feel when you first came to Christ? Do you feel that way now? What has changed?
- Life is not always easy, we experience the good, the bad and the outright ugly.

It takes perseverance to hike the AT, to walk with Christ. It takes
to be all in.

- Jesus was a hiker, he essentially walked everywhere he went--and he liked to go up to the mountains!
- Hikers know that they must _____ the trail.
- They must pursue the trail with passion, with a thirst for completion, no matter what the costs.

- Live like today is the first day and last day of your life.
- Don't let what's wrong with you keep you from what's right with God.
- Burn sinful bridges. Blaze new trails.
- Don't let fear dictate your decisions.
- Take a flying leap of faith.
- Quit holding out. Quit holding back.
- Push all of your chips to the middle of the table.
