A Lifestyle of Evangelism: Understanding the What and the How!

"An angel said to Philip, "Go south to the desert road that goes from Jerusalem to Gaza." So he went, and on his way he met an Ethiopian eunuch, an important official in charge of all the treasury of Candace, queen of Ethiopia. He had gone to Jerusalem to worship, and on his way home was sitting in his chariot reading Isaiah the prophet. The Holy Spirit said to Philip, "Go over and walk along beside the chariot." Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. "Do you understand what you are reading?" Philip asked. "How can I," he said, "unless someone explains it to me?" So he invited Philip to come and sit with him. The eunuch was reading this passage of Scripture: "He was led like a sheep to the slaughter, and as a lamb before the shearer is silent, so he did not open his mouth. In his humiliation he was deprived of justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth." The eunuch asked Philip, "Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?" Then Philip began with this passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus. As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. Why shouldn't I be baptized?" And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him. When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way rejoicing. Philip, however, appeared at Azotus and traveled about, preaching the gospel in all the towns until he reached Caesarea." Acts 8:26-40

- o Always have your heart filled with God's Word and His love---and just be ready to share!

1. The first part of God's formula is

2. The second part of God's formula is______

"For this is what the Lord has commanded us: "I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth." Acts 13:47

"People do not light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:15-16

IV. Strategic and Practical keys to success:

- a.) Commit to pray through and cultivate **YOUR** story (a testimony)
- b.) Keep it real
- c.) Point people to Jesus.
- d.) Refrain from using "Christianese"
- e.) Keep it short or concise
- f.) Be available after the conversation
- g.) Live it out---walk it out---take it seriously!
