- Friendship with a *"fair weather"* person---*"Wealth brings many friends, but a poor man's friend deserts him."* Proverbs 19:4
- **Friendship with a foolish person**---"*Whoever walks with wise people will be wise, but whoever associates with fools will suffer harm and be destroyed.*" **Proverbs 13:20**
