**1. You must believe the \_\_\_\_\_\_of the Lord---that He wants to \_\_\_\_\_\_you!** "Lord, You have seen me tossing and turning through the night. <u>You have collected all my tears</u> <u>and preserved them in your bottle</u>! You have recorded each tear in your book." Psalm 56:8 (TLB)

"He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds." Psalm 147:3 (NKJV)

"The Lord said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you...for <u>I am the LORD who heals you</u>." Exodus 15:26 (NKJV)

2. Make sure that you \_\_\_\_\_\_with trustworthy people. "I said, "I will be careful about what I do and will not let my tongue make me sin; I will not say anything...So <u>I kept quiet, not saying a word, not even about anything good! But when I did, my</u> <u>suffering only grew worse, and I was overcome with anxiety</u>. The more I thought about my trouble, the more agitated I became ..." Psalm 39:1-3

**3. Submit to God's \_\_\_\_\_\_, cooperating with Him in it.** "Who could ever have told GOD what to do or taught Him His business?" Isaiah 40:13 (MSG)

"Let us give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the God from whom all help comes. <u>He helps us in all of our troubles, so that we are able to help others who have all kinds of</u> <u>troubles,</u> using the same help that we ourselves have received from God." <u>Perfect</u>= "to mend that which is broken; to set a fracture; to mend a net"
<u>Establish</u>= "to set fast in a direction; to render immovable; unable to be overthrown"
<u>Strengthen</u>= "to supply strength to the soul, so as to be able to overcome all resistance"
<u>Settle</u>= "to lay a foundation; to be grounded on a solid foundation"

4. You must intentionally and daily \_\_\_\_\_\_. "...<u>When Jesus saw the paralytic lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a</u> <u>long time, He asked the man, "Do you want to get well?</u>" John 5:2-10

## Things that you must do:

- o Decide once and for all that you want to get well---no matter the cost
- o Begin to pray daily, "Lord, heal my mind and my memories."
- o Fill and renew your mind daily with God's Word-the Bible
- o Spend time with people of faith and genuine spirituality
- o Heal along with others knowing that everyone needs healing from something
- o Believe and declare what God says about you and your situation
- o Refuse to allow your past to become your future
