## **II. Things to Remember In the Battle of Fearing Lack**

#### 1. God has exactly \_

"And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from His glorious riches, <u>which</u> <u>have been given to us in Christ Jesus.</u>" Philippians 4:19 (NLT)

## 2. We must decide each day to \_\_\_\_

"So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the unbelievers run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But <u>seek first the kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.</u> Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own." Matthew 6:31-34

## 3. We must decide each day to \_

"Then the word of the LORD came to Elijah: "Leave here, turn eastward and hide in the Kerith Ravine, east of the Jordan. You will drink from the brook, and <u>I have ordered the ravens to feed you THERE</u>." So he did what the LORD had told him. He went to the Kerith Ravine, east of the Jordan, and stayed there. The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he drank from the brook. <u>Some time later the brook dried up</u> because there had been no rain in the land. Then the word of the LORD came to him: "<u>Go at once to Zarephath of Sidon and stay there.</u> *Lhave commanded a widow in that place to supply you with food.*" So he went to Zarephath. When he came to the town gate, a widow was there gathering sticks. He called to her and asked, "Would you bring me a little water in a jar so I may have a drink?" As she was going to get it, he called, "And bring me, please, a piece of bread." "As surely as the LORD your God lives," she replied, "I don't have any bread--only a handful of flour in a jar and a little oil in a jug. I am gathering a few sticks to take home and make a meal for myself and my son that we may eat it--and die." Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. **BUT FIRST make a small cake of bread for me** from what you have and bring it to me, and then make something for yourself and your son. For this is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: 'The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the LORD gives rain on the land.'" She went away and did as Elijah had told her. **So there was food every day** for Elijah and for the woman and her family. For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the LORD..." I Kings 17:2-16

## 4. Be certain to do what you can do because\_\_\_\_

"The wife of a man from the company of the prophets cried out to Elisha, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that he revered the LORD. But now his creditor is coming to take my two boys as his slaves." Elisha replied to her, "How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house?" "Your servant has nothing there at all," she said, "except a little oil." Elisha said, "Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars. Don't ask for just a few. Then go inside and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour oil into all the jars, and as each is filled, put it to one side." **II Kings 4:1-4** 

## 5. No matter your circumstances, always \_\_\_\_\_

"So she shut the door behind her and her sons. They brought the jars to her and she kept pouring. <u>When all the jars were full, she said to her son, "Bring me another one." But he replied, "There is</u> <u>not a jar left." Then the oil stopped flowing.</u> She went and told the man of God, and he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debts. <u>You and your sons can live on what is left</u>." II Kings 4:5-7

- ✓ OUR EXPECTANCY OFTEN DETERMINES THE LEVEL OF BLESSING THAT WE LIVE IN.
- ✓ THERE WILL RARELY BE A TIME WHEN DOING THE RIGHT THING IN AND BY FAITH WILL CORRESPOND TO WHAT OUR NATURAL MIND WOULD ORDINARILY BE PRONE TO DO (SEE Pro.3:5, 6; I Cor.2:11-16)
