#### **I. Introduction**

"But <u>seek first</u> the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." **Matthew 6:33** 

**Seek**: (zeteo, Gr.)= "to make efforts to find; to aim at; to strive after; to be consumed by that search."

Key thought to remember: "If you put God first, you will never be last!"

Seeking God's things isn't a homework assignment—it's much more like a treasure map quest!
