II. The Four Characteristics of Healthy Trees

1. Healthy trees grow a_

"But <u>since they don't have deep roots, they don't last long</u>. They fall away as soon as they have problems or are persecuted for believing God's word." Mark 4:17 (NLT)

"Just as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, continue to live together as Christ's people. <u>Now sink your</u> <u>roots down deep into Jesus and build on Him.</u> Be strengthened by the faith that you were taught, and overflow with thanksgiving each day." **Colossians 2:6-7**

"Then Christ will make His home in your hearts as you trust in Him. <u>Your roots will grow down into</u> <u>God's love and keep you strong</u>." Ephesians 3:17 (NLT)

Key thoughts:

- o The average tree has roots that extend downward 1 ½ times the height of the tree!
- o Character development is more important than gift development
- o Behind every outward success story, there is a much longer developmental process that precedes it
- o Overnight successes are usually followed by some very public failures
- o Sometimes God's blessings and protection are in His "No" instead of His "Yes!"
